# Christmas Artisans Festival

## November 6 – 28

PVAA is sponsoring a **Christmas Artisans Festival** during the month of November. It will be open during Regular Gallery SoHo hours Thursday Through Sunday, November 6<sup>th</sup> through 28<sup>th</sup>. Set-up will be November 1<sup>st</sup> through Friday the 5<sup>th</sup>. Opening day will be Saturday the 6<sup>th</sup>. Tear down will be Sunday the 28<sup>th</sup> after 4 pm. through Tuesday the 30<sup>th</sup>.

- ★ Each space will be 10' X 10 for \$25. It is your responsibility to set up your own area... tables, panels, display items, etc.
- ★ All merchandise will be sold through Gallery SoHo and a 10% commission will be taken. Gallery SoHo has MasterCard and Visa to assist in sales. The gallery collects sales tax and will pay the tax to the state.
- ★ Your booth number will be noted on your sales slips. Each exhibitor will be required to have price tags on their merchandise with the price **AND** their booth number. This will insure that those working the festival will give you credit for your sales.
- ★ Exhibitors will be required to donate 5 hours of their time to work at the Festival. Working more hours is encouraged.
- ★ Checks will be issued the week after the closing of the Festival and can be picked up at the gallery or can be mailed to you.
- ★ Specific Festival Hours are as follows:  
Thursday – Sunday, 11 am - 4 pm. On November 13<sup>th</sup>, which is our "Art Walk" night, the festival will remain open till 10 pm. It is strongly suggested that each person be there on this evening because we always have a large crowd on Second Saturdays.

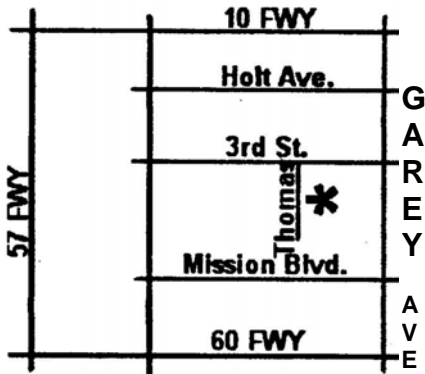
