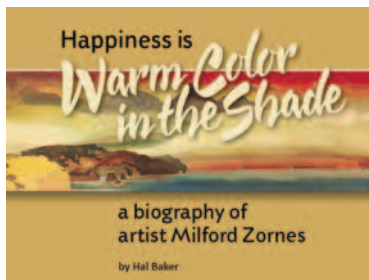

About the event: The therapeutic artistic project by RLO is the first of the travel series "Something JazzZee", recapturing the move groove of my dad hitting the road on Route 66, "When the rubber hits the road". RLO using the old tire inner tube displays the travels west from The Harlem Hotel in East Saint Louis Illinois to the Dunbar Hotel in Los Angeles, one step at a time. The Negro Motorist GREEN BOOK was used as the GPS of the past to navigate the Jim Crow attitudes and discrimination on the historic "Americas Highway Route 66."

What is Zen Brush?

Zen monks strive for enlightenment by living in the present moment: listening (not just hearing), looking (not just seeing), experiencing (not just being). This meditative practice created an Eastern calligraphic tradition from the 1600s on called Zenga.

Susan is not a Zen monk, not even a Buddhist, but was taught this practice by two Zen monks whom she met and worked with for many years through the meditative art – Aikido, an art designed to awaken the inner spirit. Susan says, "The Zen Brush stroke is notable because it is complete as it stands; no repair or additions are used. The artist's aim is to be a vehicle for natural energy to express itself through the brush. In this way one communicates life to the strokes and so creates lines that are alive."

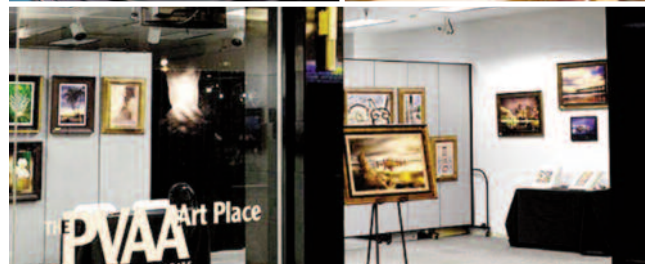
