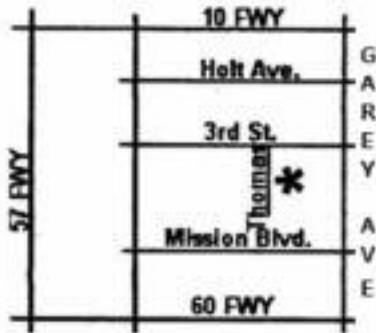

LET'S PAINT! Join Our PVAA Paint-In & Creative Gathering

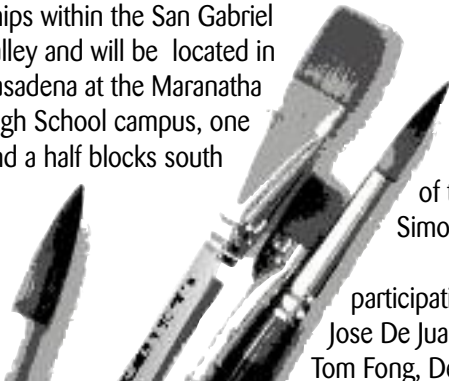
