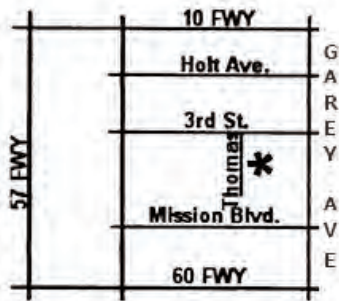

I am largely a self-taught painter born in PERU.



Since I started drawing and painting at a young age, I was completely captivated by people and their environment. I keep painting without breaks since then; whether just

for my own enjoyment or for private commission. It was during the last two years when I realize that art was more than just a hobby, as people were showing a lot of interest in my work. Subsequently I produced some private commis-

sions; and the journey of the ART as a career started there.

My paintings, synthesized from sketches from life and from my imagination, backed up by photographs and memories; are a dialogue between the observed and the remembered, the planned and the surprise that happens on the canvas. They are

the starting point for the exciting process of painting which is as much about imagination and experience as about the rendering or realization of specific images. I use oil paint on canvas and try to show a glimpse of various life realistic landscapes and urban scenes, cap-

turing a sense of time and place, light and space in California.

Light is the main focus of most of my paintings, but also love to depict water as I enjoy the way in which light is reflected and the patterns created by ripples.

Paintings in a variety subject matter— Landscapes, seascapes, urban scenes, people, nature, animals, etc. My goal is to paint with a freshness, energy and



and expression. Since I started showing my art to the public in August 2012. I participate in different exhibitions thru Galleries like: "The Liberty

Gallery" in Long Beach, CA. "Show case night" at the Santa Fe Springs Art Fest. "Chateau L'Amour" Gallery in Ontario, CA. Long Beach and Ontario Art Walks.
